They will spend the day working with children from Year 1 through to Year 6, talking & alerting them to the dangers and risks of internet use, online bullying, apps and mobile phone use. Each talk will be age appropriate and teachers will follow up sessions.

As requested by many parents, the “Two Johns” will also run a hard hitting parent meeting from 6.00 to 8.00pm in the Junior School Hall.
